## VOLLEYBALL SET FOR TWO HOME MATCHES THIS WEEKEND

**PARKVILLE, Mo.** - The No. 4 ranked Park University men's volleyball team will look to bounce back after a tough conference loss earlier this week, as they host Hannibal-LaGrange College this Friday, Feb. 26 at 7:00 p.m. and Missouri Baptist University this Saturday, Feb. 27 at 1:00 p.m.

The Pirates dropped a thrilling five game match to fellow MAMVIC West opponent Missouri Valley last Tuesday evening at the Breckon Sports Center for their first conference loss of the season.

Park is now 8-4 on the year and 5-1 in the conference, while Hannibal-LaGrange comes into Parkville with a 6-9 overall record and 1-6 MAMVIC West record. Missouri Baptist and Park met back on Feb. 20 on Mo Bap's campus, the Pirates prevailed in a 3-0 victory. MBU is 7-7 on the year and 3-2 in MAMVIC West action.

The Pirates are averaging 14.13 kills per game this season and Fray Luis Arteaga has continually led Park in kills all season long.

Arteaga has a team high 161 kills on the year, and averages 4.03 per game. Zach Penolio is second on the team in kills with 133 and 3.17 per game.

Park's leader in service aces this season is sophomore setter Philip Heckmann. The Schuettorf, Germany native has 17 service aces this season and is second on the team in assists with 57.

Park's starting setter, Felix Horn has an astounding, 544 assists on the year. He had all of Park's assists but one in the loss against Mo Valley, collecting 65 of the Pirates 66 assists.

Hannibal-LaGrange has many players with over 100 kills this season including Matheus Roham, who leads the Trojans in kills with 190. Jake Wollenberg has 150 kills, while Breno Bianchetti has 101 and Tom Burke has 100 on the year.

The Trojans have lost four straight matches and picked up its only conference win of the year back on January 26 against Graceland.

Missouri Baptist is ranked No. 7 in the country and picked up a huge victory early on in the season, upsetting the No. 1 team in the country California Baptist, in three sets back on Jan. 28.

## HORN WINS NAIA SETTER OF THE WEEK FOR SECOND TIME

For the second time this season, Park's freshman setter Felix Horn was named the NAIA Setter of the Week for his brilliant play over the weekend.

Horn led Park to a 2-1 record last week defeating Missouri Baptist and Fontbonne University and losing in three games to Clarke College.

The freshman out of Biberg, Germany, averaged 10.6 assists per game and 1.67 digs per game for the week. Horn is the team leader in assists this season with 479 and averages 12.28 assists per game.

Horn is tied for second on the team in service aces with 13 and second on the squad in digs with 76. He is also among the team leaders in blocks with 27.

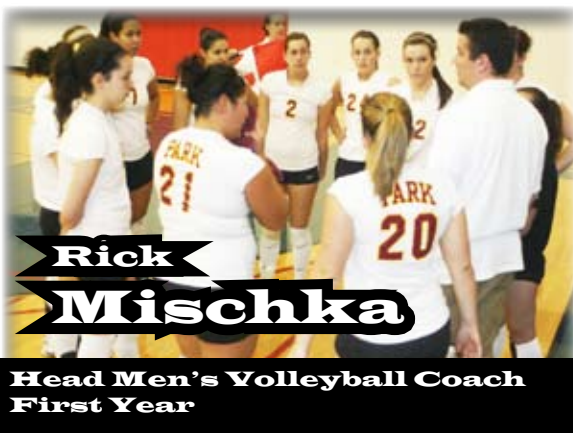

**R**ick Mischka became the fifth head coach in the history of the Park men's volleyball program and the sixth head coach in Pirate women's volleyball history on May 13, 2009, and enters his first season as head men's and women's volleyball coach at Park University in the 2009-10 season.

"Rick is an outstanding recruiter and has the energy and enthusiasm that it will take to run two successful programs on the high level we expect at Park University," said Director of Athletics Claude English. "He possesses all the tools to get the job done on this campus, and it starts with his ability to bring in the kind of quality student-athletes who can make a difference both on and off the court for our volleyball programs."

Mischka comes to Park from Kansas Wesleyan University, where in 2008, he coached the Coyotes to a semifinal appearance in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference tournament and five wins in the team's last nine matches.

He also coached one first-team All-KCAC performer, as well as one Daktronics-NAIA Scholar Athlete in 2008.

In his first year as the women's coach at Park, Mischka led the Pirates to a 7-24 record and had two Daktronics-NAIA scholar-athletes in Bethany Buehler and Crystal Cole. Four Pirates were also named to the Academic All-AMC team and sophomore setter Gabriela Garcia was named to the Honorable Mention All-AMC team for her stellar play.

"Rick will run disciplined programs, but at the same time, our student-athletes will get the most out of their experience at Park University because of his energy and character, which are both outstanding," English said. "We are very excited to have someone of his caliber on our staff."

Before Kansas Wesleyan, Mischka was an assistant coach at NCAA Division-III Saint Mary's University in Winona, Minn., where he was responsible for all aspects of the program, and was a major part of the recruiting process. In his two-plus seasons at SMU, the Cardinals rebounded from a 10-19 record in 2006 to a 17-12 overall mark in 2007.

Mischka has also been strongly involved in the USA Volleyball Junior Olympic program for the last five years, spending the past two with the Southern Minnesota Volleyball program. During those two years, he has served as head coach of the 17-elite team that finished the 2007 season 35-22 and was 34th out of 64 teams at the AAU Nationals in Orlando, Fla.

"This is my dream job," Mischka said. "I have wanted to be a dual head coach since graduating from college, and Park is an elite program within the NAIA. Park has the resources to be a nationally recognized program on both sides – men and women – so this is a very exciting move for my career."

Before Saint Mary's, Mischka was an assistant coach at Graceland University, where he worked with both the men's and women's programs for two seasons.

Mischka played three years at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point where he was co-captain, player-coach and team treasurer for the Pointers' NIRSA collegiate club team. While at UWSP, he received NIRSA Club National Championships All-National Team honors as a setter.

Mischka then transferred to Graceland where he played for two seasons as setter and right side hitter for the Yellow Jackets before graduating in 2006 with a double-major in Philosophy and Religion. He is currently pursuing his Master of Arts in Human Development at Saint Mary's.

He is also a certified firefighter, and holds a valid Emergency Medical Technician license, obtained through the Wisconsin Technical College system.
