PARKVILLE, Mo. - After going 2-2 in the Lindenwood Tournament last week against some of the top men's volleyball programs in the country, Park University will return to MAMVIC West play this Tuesday, Feb. 2 against Missouri Valley on the road at 7:00 p.m.

Park defeated No. 2 Hope International and No. 3 ranked Cardinal Stritch over the weekend in St. Charles, Mo., but dropped matches to No. 1 California Baptist and St. Ambrose to bring their overall record to 3-2.

Park's match against Cardinal Stritch was an instant classic, as the Pirates trailed two games to zero and fought back to win the final three games and clinch the victory over the No. 3 ranked Wolves.

Fray Luis Fajardo Arteaga had a phenomenal match for Park against Cardinal Stritch, knocking down 27 kills and had a hitting percentage of .561. He also had two service aces and 13 digs in the match.

Freshman Felix Horn also played outstanding against the Wolves, registering 69 assists and had five kills on five attempts.

The Pirates match with Hope International went four games with the Pirates winning games two, 34-32, three, 30-22, and game four 30-27.

Four Pirates had 10 or more kills against the Royals, as freshman Zach Penolio highlighted the group with 18 kills and hit a stifling .341.

Junior Erick Albuquerque also had 15 kills, along with freshman Luis Zepeda who had 12 and freshman Wilfredo Lopez added 11.

Horn leads those Pirates with at least 10 kills this year in hitting percentage at .529, but Lopez is not far behind with his percentage of .456 on 33 kills.

Arteaga leads all Pirates in kills with 71, while Zach Penolio only trails him by three with his 68 kills.

Jake Penolio have split time together at the middle blocking position and both have performed quite well in Park's first five matches. Both have a team high 20 blocks and Penolio has appeared in one more game than Lopez, as he has seen the floor in 22 games, which is also a team high.

Missouri Valley comes into the match with a record of 0-2, losing to Missouri Baptist and Lindenwood earlier in the year. Both matches ended in three games.

NOTES ON PARK...

- As a tem Park now has exactly 300 kills, averaging 13.64 per game. The Pirates also feature a .282 hitting percentage.

- Sophomore setter Philip Heckmann leads Park in service aces with 10.

- 11 players have seen the floor so far for Park this season. Zach Penolio, Jake Penolio and Erick Albuquerque lead the team in games played with 22.

Rick Mischka became the fifth head coach in the history of the Park men's volleyball program and the sixth head coach in Pirate women's volleyball history on May 13, 2009, and enters his first season as head men's and women's volleyball coach at Park University in the 2009-10 season.

"Rick is an outstanding recruiter and has the energy and enthusiasm that it will take to run two successful programs on the high level we expect at Park University," said Director of Athletics Claude English. "He possesses all the tools to get the job done on this campus, and it starts with his ability to bring in the kind of quality student-athletes who can make a difference both on and off the court for our volleyball programs."

Mischka comes to Park from Kansas Wesleyan University, where in 2008, he coached the Coyotes to a semifinal appearance in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference tournament and five wins in the team's last nine matches.

He also coached one first-team All-KCAC performer, as well as one Daktronics-NAIA Scholar Athlete in 2008.

In his first year as the women's coach at Park, Mischka led the Pirates to a 7-24 record and had two Daktronics-NAIA scholar-athletes in Bethany Buehler and Crystal Cole. Four Pirates were also named to the Academic All-AMC team and sophomore setter Gabriela Garcia was named to the Honorable Mention All-AMC team for her stellar play.

"Rick will run disciplined programs, but at the same time, our student-athletes will get the most out of their experience at Park University because of his energy and character, which are both outstanding," English said. "We are very excited to have someone of his caliber on our staff."

Before Kansas Wesleyan, Mischka was an assistant coach at NCAA Division-III Saint Mary's University in Winona, Minn., where he was responsible for all aspects of the program, and was a major part of the recruiting process. In his two-plus seasons at SMU, the Cardinals rebounded from a 10-19 record in 2006 to a 17-12 overall mark in 2007.

Mischka has also been strongly involved in the USA Volleyball Junior Olympic program for the last five years, spending the past two with the Southern Minnesota Volleyball program. During those two years, he has served as head coach of the 17-elite team that finished the 2007 season 35-22 and was 34th out of 64 teams at the AAU Nationals in Orlando, Fla.

"This is my dream job," Mischka said. "I have wanted to be a dual head coach since graduating from college, and Park is an elite program within the NAIA. Park has the resources to be a nationally recognized program on both sides – men and women – so this is a very exciting move for my career."

Before Saint Mary's, Mischka was an assistant coach at Graceland University, where he worked with both the men's and women's programs for two seasons.

Mischka played three years at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point where he was co-captain, player-coach and team treasurer for the Pointers' NIRSA collegiate club team. While at UWSP, he received NIRSA Club National Championships All-National Team honors as a setter.

Mischka then transferred to Graceland where he played for two seasons as setter and right side hitter for the Yellow Jackets before graduating in 2006 with a double-major in Philosophy and Religion. He is currently pursuing his Master of Arts in Human Development at Saint Mary's.

He is also a certified firefighter, and holds a valid Emergency Medical Technician license, obtained through the Wisconsin Technical College system.
